HEALTH ALERT CARD FOR IALA DIPLOMATIC CONFERENCE 2020 DELEGATION

Keep this card for the next 14 days after arrival in Malaysia. Monitor your body temperature and look out for fever ($\geq 38^{\circ}$ C) and symptoms of cough with breathlessness. If these symptoms were to develop or worsen and you are not feeling well, please seek medical treatment at nearest healthcare facility **IMMEDIATELY**

As such, kindly practice the following:

- (i) Cover your mouth and nose using tissue whenever you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the thrash after you use it. Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer regularly;
- (ii) Always follow cough etiquette;
- (iii) Use face mask whenever being in public or close contact with people; and
- (iv) Always maintain good personal hygiene and cleanliness.

Attention to the Attending Doctor:

The person who is presenting this **ALERT CARD** is an IALA Diplomatic Conference 2020 delegate and requires medical treatment. If the person presents with fever (≥ 38°C), pneumonia or severe respiratory infection with breathlessness, please refer him/her **IMMEDIATELY** to the nearest hospital.
