The Netherlands Ministry of Infrastructure and Water Management together with IALA and the City of Rotterdam are hosting the 14th IALA Symposium between the 12 and 16 April 2021. Registration is now open on the dedicated Symposium web site.

The theme for the Symposium is Enhanced Maritime Safety and Efficiency by Connectivity.

The Symposium will provide a unique online meeting space offering excellent opportunities for networking during an interactive five day programme that will be broadcast live from Rotterdam.
