In view of the continuing pandemic situation, the 73rd session of the IALA Council will be held via virtual means from 8 to 10 June 2021. The format is proposed in the following:

Monday 7 June: FAC meeting 10h00 to 11h00 UTC (only for FAC members)

Tuesday 8 June: Plenary meeting 10h00 to 12h00 UTC

Wednesday 9 June: Council meeting continues 10h00 to 12h00 UTC

Thursday 10 June: Plenary meeting 10h00 to 12h00 UTC for approval of the report.

The time differences require meetings to be limited in time and some regular agenda items will need to be shorten or omitted.

According to Article 4.3.3 of the General Regulations providing for the organisation of Council meetings I invite you to send me papers addressing matters that you wish to discuss at the Council, or any other paper that you wish to submit to Council for information, for example on national matters. These will need to reach me by 8 May 2021. A final draft Agenda will be developed in accordance and made available four weeks before the meeting starts, together with the meeting documents. These will be available on the usual place on the IALA web site.
